- We are using [Pledgestar](#) online fundraising platform for easy collective fundraising. [Pledgestar](#) makes it simple to send pledge emails and share to social media to get the most fundraising possibilities.
- Please see the attached [Pledgestar](#) instruction sheet or CSIPTO.com/wat for more information on setting up your personal student page and keeping track of your student's activities.
- We are offering a paper-only option for those who prefer to fundraise in person. If you choose this option, please return the pledge sheet (attached) by 4/23 to the Welcome Center with any checks made out to "CSI PTO" or cash. Please clearly label the cash with "CSIPTO/WAT".

How to Participate

This year, students complete "activities" over a two-week period. (They will NOT be walking laps at school like in the past.) Activities could include reading minutes, acts of kindness, physical and creative activities, or personal goals students may have for themselves. See the attached [Activity Card](#) for activity ideas. These will be done from home and logged online by an adult on the student's [Pledgestar](#) page. Friends and family may pledge funds either per "activity" or flat rate, both are options on your student [Pledgestar](#) page with easy instructions.

Prizes

There are three ways for [individuals](#) to earn prizes:

1. Just for participating by entering your activity amounts to your online [Pledgestar](#) page by 4/23 students will be entered in a drawing. There will also be drawings for students who raise over \$100, \$250, and \$500. Students may only win one prize to allow for as many winners as possible. 2. On [Pledgestar](#), we can view the number of pledge requests that are shared via email and social media, so there will be a winner for sending out the most pledge requests per grade level. **Our success depends on you reaching out to all of your family, friends and neighbors!**
3. For having the most funds raised per grade level.

There are also [class prizes](#) for the most pledge requests sent out and the most funds raised school wide.

To Register your Student(s):

- When you finish, the system emails pledge requests to your family and friends, and allows them to make secure credit card donations online. You get notified each time a pledge is made, and you can track your pledge progress online.

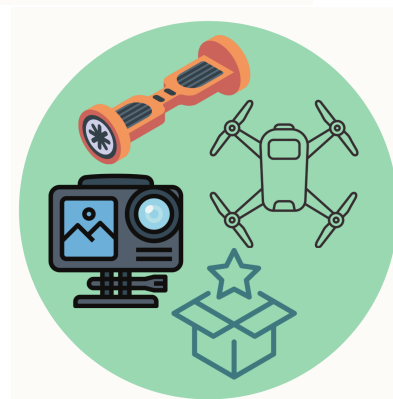
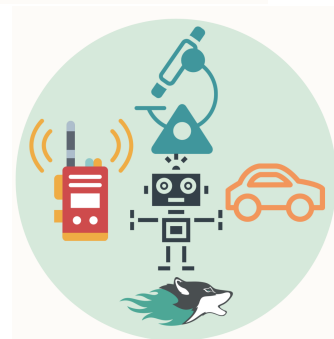

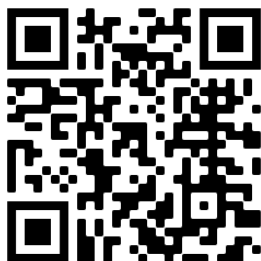
Wolf-A-Thon Prize List
